

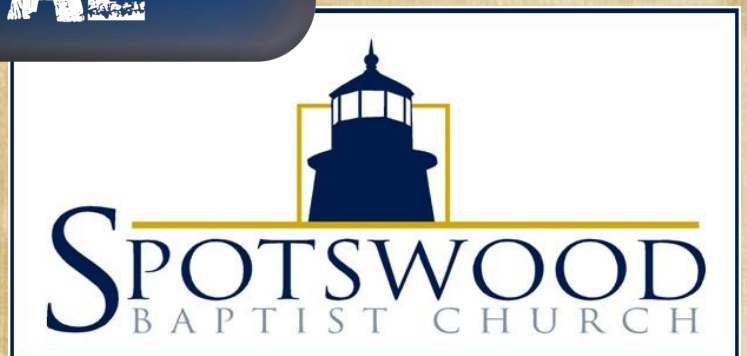

What Fundraising opportunities are available?

- **Mission Bucks**—In the spring, our students will have an opportunity to sell Mission Bucks cards to people in the church. These cards provide a discount to the purchaser at our donuts/coffee sale on Sunday mornings. Each item purchased is \$1, but the purchase of a Mission Bucks card allows the purchaser to receive two items for free. NOTE—Mission Trip participants must serve time at the Mission Bucks counter to sell the coffee and donuts. This also allows the students opportunities to sell their own Mission Bucks Cards.
- **Golf Tournament**—Spotswood's 2nd Annual Golf Open will provide opportunities for men and organizations to play golf while providing support for our PowerPlant Mission Team. The 2012 Golf Open will be held on May 14th. Students are encouraged to spread the word to find golfers who are willing and able to play on that day. Students are also encouraged to submit names of businesses to our Fundraising Chairman who will seek out door prizes and sponsorships from these businesses.
- **6th Annual "On A Mission" Car Show**—Every participant must plan to help with the Car Show. Your involvement will begin at 6AM and last through 4PM. If parents are available to help, we appreciate any and all efforts to make the day go smoothly. Our 2012 Car Show is scheduled for April 28, 2012. You can begin spreading the word now by inviting people with show-worthy automobiles to enter their cars into the car show.
- **Christmas Tree Sales**—Our students have an opportunity to sell Christmas trees with the profits designated to benefit our participating students in their mission trip fundraising. Details will be available in the near future.
- **Your Support Circle**—All students have people in their lives who might be interested in making a tax-deductible donation to support them. We will provide sample letters to get you started. Your biggest fundraiser will be through your efforts in sending out the word about your trip. Be praying now that the Lord will lay your support needs on the hearts of those who will receive your letter.

How much support do I need to raise?

The cost of our Philadelphia 2012 Mission Trip has been broken down into the following categories:

PowerPlant Fee:	\$269
Transportation:	\$ 51 (subject to change due to fuel cost & number of participants)
<u>Meals:</u>	<u>\$ 100</u>
TOTAL:	\$420

NOTE: Be prepared to pay for the following out-of-pocket costs:

- Snacks
- Souvenirs

Payment Schedule:

- January 11, 2012—Deposit of \$100
- March 4, 2012—Payment of \$100
- April 1, 2012—Payment of \$110
- May 6, 2012—Payment of \$110
